This year, as part of ESSA Title VI – Native Language Immersion, the Bureau of Indian Education is beginning a new project to evaluate, improve, and strengthen Native American languages at BIE schools. This project will be based on first assessing where schools are with their Native language instructional programs, determining strengths and weakness, and working with administrators, teachers and other stakeholders on shaping what resources should be developed and applied to improving language teaching outcomes.

The BIE has contracted The Language Conservancy, a national leader in Native language support services to conduct school visits, provide professional development training, and create an overall report about BIE schools in the North Region.
